

Introduction

Denbighshire



- Population 93,065
- Mainly rural county in North Wales
- Urban areas along the coastal strip
- Main route (A55T) to Ireland



Street Lighting Section

- In-house service within the Environment Directorate
- Combined client / contractor service
- Provided by private contractor until 2004
- Integrated with Sign Manufacturing and Installation

12,623 Lighting units

1,398 Illuminated signs

279 Traffic bollards



The Way We Were

- The street lighting service previously been provided by outside contactor.
- During the early stages of the contract the performance and service delivery was average at best.
- Denbighshire was placed in the lower quartile.
- The service then went from bad to worse with the contractor going into administration.
- The client spent a great deal of time checking the contractors work leaving very little time for improvement initiatives in service delivery.



Improvement Strategy

- The Council took the decision to place the Street Lighting contract out to tender.
- The in house tender was successful and the team developed a new business plan.
- The fundamental strategy was to provide a top quality one stop shop for the design, build and maintenance of all signing and lighting works.
- The plan included a major investment in training for all members of staff based on NVQ assessments.
- A complete overhaul of risk assessments and safe working procedures.



Improvement Strategy

 Overheads would be reduced by changing the previous separate client and contractor roles to combine a more efficient streamlined operation

 This would be further aided with the introduction of new electronic systems to assist planning, work scheduling system updates, invoicing, and budgetary financial control

Staffing

- All outside staff trained to at least NVQ2 Sign Shop Staff NVQ3
- Installation works are carried out by four multi skilled teams of two men
- All site foremen trained to same level
- All installation operatives have same skills
- All staff have at least LGV2 via NVQ route
- All staff attend DNO course to allow safe working on equipment



Fault Reporting

- Call Centre

Working Arrangements

- Following inspections the faults are loaded onto Street Lighting Management System
- Start of each day list of faults are uploaded onto PDA's for each Electrician to plan daily programme
- End of shift repairs downloaded from PDA's back into the management system



Revised Working Arrangements

- Introduction of Night Shift for all Electrical Maintenance
- Team of two Electrician and Mate
- Start Shift at 16.00hrs
- 37 hours Monday Thursday
- Team will finish at 2.45am but remain on call until 07.30am
- Night Shift Fortnightly
- Patrol and attend to fault



Advantages

- Easier to plan
- Need to comply with EU Drivers hours (Digital Tachographs fitted to all street lighting vehicles)
- More efficient fault repairs
- Anticipate improved Performance Indicators
- Less risk eliminate single man patrolling



Winter Maintenance

Street Lighting/Sign Shop provides staff for

- Highway Emergency Response (Summer and Winter)
- Front Line Gritter Operation (all single manning)

Collaboration/Joint Procurement

- Historically a forum for "Client" Lighting Engineers
- Most North Wales Authorities now combined client / contractor
- Focus of meeting changed to best value initiatives and method improvements

- Exchange of Safe Working Procedures and Risk Assessments



Joint Procurement Initiative - Need For Change

- Compliance with financial regulations
- Benefits of joint procurement existed for energy
- Partnerships/collaboration meet both Corporate and Departmental business aims and objectives
- Stronger purchasing power due to increased quantities
- Associated cost of stock holding in order to complete works on time
- Standardisation of component parts

Savings

 In addition to the savings realised by the Street Lighting Section, The Building Maintenance Section will also benefit from the tender.

Bulk lamp replacements in schools and other public buildings.



Benefits

- Compliance with EU Procurement regulations and also our own Financial Regulations
- Reduction in the number of suppliers from 12 down to 3
- Prices within the agreement cover the bulk of items sourced
- New Purchase Order templates created and introduced into our stores for each supplier to be emailed once a month saving on time and paperwork and significantly reducing number of orders placed
- Reduction in the number of invoices (one invoice per month from 3 suppliers)
- Lead times reduced as distributors agreed to hold stocks on our behalf based on our minimum stock levels



Benefits

- Better Planning shorter lead times enable better planning of our resources and workload and also to respond to emergency situations.
- Reduction in the number of deliveries to the depot this will in turn reduce the carbon footprint due to vehicle mileage.
- Allowed closer working and collaboration with neighbouring authorities, the North Wales Street Lighting engineers have reached a partial agreement on the standardisation of product specification.
- Two year agreement with the option to extend for a further two years depending upon performance.
- Price variation clauses in the contract which prevent the suppliers raising prices without consultation.

This agreement is available for use by any of the Welsh authorities and all other Public Sector bodies should they wish to use it
