APSE National Update



- APSE has recently published its latest research paper on 'Governance, neighbourhoods and service delivery' and one on 'exploring the economic footprint of public services'
- This ground breaking piece of research examines the best operational arrangements for local authorities, delivering services at a neighbourhood level, and how to best secure due governance arrangements with the critical involvement of elected members
- Research will now also be carried out in Scotland with West Lothian Council/APSE part funding
- Further research hopefully to be carried out using other Scottish Authorities



Wales



- APSE continues to discuss the use of performance networks data with the 'Ffynnon' national performance system for Wales and is launching a pilot project in November. APSE is also exhibiting at the WLGA open day on 12/13 November
- APSE has met with the Welsh Audit Office with regard to school meals catering performance in Wales and is collaborating on a project on school meals performance for Welsh authorities
