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Requirement under the Act*

- Planning analysis of menus
- Provision of meals that meet Nutritional Regulations (based on estimated selections by pupils)
- Continuous improvement

* Schools (Health Promotion and Nutrition)(Scotland) Act 2007

Planning Analysis

• Principles

Data - collection, input and analysis

• Ensuring the correct input

Meal Equivalents

What counts as a meal?

What about the single food or drink items selected by Pupils?





Planning Analysis cont'd

• Vending machines

Important to include these if they are used as additional sales points to serve meals.

 Information to be provided regarding the analysis Substitution of menu item, portion sizes and if meal price is inclusive of items such as vegetables, dessert or soup or if the policy is to serve a meal with accompaniments without choice.
