

- 200% increase in capacity


#### **EMPLOYMENT**

#### BINGE DRINKING

- 23% of adult males and 9% of adult females engage in binge drinking
- 5.9 million people!
- UK death rates due to intoxication have doubled in 20 years
- 29% of alcohol related deaths are from injury – mainly in 16 –34 year olds



- Alcohol misuse is closely linked with anti social and violent behaviour
- 30% sexual offences
- 50% of street crimes
- 70% of A&E attendance between midnight and 5am

- 3 pubs a week are closing
- Alcohol Disorder Zones being intoduced
- Internet New ways to socialise
- Reducing alcohol related harm strategy





77% of men and over 90% of women don't binge drink

The truth is that only a minority of Britain's drinkers are binge drinkers - but this behaviour is concentrated in city centres and on weekends, maximising its impact on society.

By contrast, the higher alcohol consumption in Europe is less intense, reducing drunkenness, public order issues and other negative effects of alcohol consumption,"
