- Review of decisions of RPA as they related to local government
- Parallel modernising programme





Review

- Review to consider role and function of local government in context of devolved administration
- Context for review is the strategic direction of the RPA, in its entirety, as agreed by the Executive
- Process for review to be discussed by Executive at meeting on 5 July





Review Terms of Reference

- Role and function of local government in the context of a devolved Assembly and Executive
- Number of councils required to deliver this is in context of 3 options consulted upon as part of the RPA process
- Functions that the Executive believe should be delivered by local government – in context of those considered by the RPA process





Review Timetable and Key elements

July / August – desk research, analysis and bilateral discussions with Ministers and others

September - emerging findings paper to Executive

September / October – engagement with key stakeholders including Environment Committee to refine findings

November – Report to Executive





Modernising Programme

- Two strands
 - Legislative framework and capacity building.
 - Service improvement





Legislative Framework & Capacity Building

- Intended to strengthen way in which Councils work
- By modernising policy & legislative framework
- By addressing capacity of Councils to deliver accountable, citizen-centred services





Legislative Framework & Capacity Building

- Local Government finance arrangements
- Remuneration & Severance arrangements for Councillors
- Ethical standards, including mandatory code of conduct for Councillors
- Regulatory framework in relation to Council's participation in limited companies
- Provisions to allow Council's to participate in PPP & PFI





Legislative Framework & Capacity Building

- Performance management framework
- New governance arrangements within Councils
- Strategy to support capacity of elected members and staff to deliver strong, accountable, citizen-centred local government





Service Improvement

- Intended to improve way in which Councils work
- To deliver business-related services standardised, simple, VFM
- To enable resources to be released to improve front-line service delivery





Service Improvement

- Front-line customer service mechanisms
- Back-office service delivery (HR, finance, procurement, & estates)
- Common ICT infrastructure for local government
