- An established network of locally based, community focussed, easily accessible jogging groups enabling
- An initiative which encourages participation in regular physical activity and making healthier lifestyle choices.
- A springboard to other activities
- A signpost to other services
- Supported by local and national partners
- Social and enjoyable

Background

- Based on Jog Scotland model
- Initially part of Jog England concept
- Delivered by Derbyshire Sport
- Part of Active Derbyshire







Who is it aimed at?

- Adult population (16yr +) but with specific KPI for O45 participation
- Those who are 'new to exercise'
- Those with health risks
- All fitness and ability levels
- Both community and work-based groups

- Derbyshire County Primary Care Trust
- England Athletics







Aims of the project

- 3000 joggers in 3 years
- Over 300 qualified Jog Leaders
- Over 200 groups established county wide
- Reduce health inequalities
- Encourage healthier lifestyle choices
- Increase physical activity levels in our adult population
 - Hard to reach groups
 - Lower Super Output Areas



Our First Year Targets


- 800 new joggers
 - 3 100 per Local Authority District
 - 70% of participants "new to exercise"
 - ★ 40% Over 45
- 56 jogging groups established across the county
 - Including 8 work-based groups
- 80 qualified Jog Leaders
