Key Executive Decisions

Election in May 2011 to 26 Councils

 Reduction from 26 to 11 Councils is still the objective

 Timescale dependent on proposals to be put to the Executive

Unlikely to fund in the current climate

Next Steps

- Paper to the Executive with options for the delivery timetable
- Potentially shadow council in 2014 and move to 11 new Councils in 2015



Legislation - Bills

- Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland) 2010
- Local Government (Finance) Bill in progress through Assembly
- Boundaries Bill awaiting Executive consideration
- Reorganisation Bill awaiting Executive consideration



Legislation

- Reorganisation Bill not possible to get through the Assembly before dissolution
- But keen to proceed with consultation on policy proposals on the Bill
- Planning Bill deliver a reformed planning system
- Hope to introduce Bill to Assembly in December 2010



Next Steps

- Keen to proceed with Community Planning power and power of well being
- Happy to re-engage with Ministers on transferring functions when Executive decide on way forward



Collaboration and Efficiency

- Minister wants to ensure Council cooperation and collaboration to benefit ratepayers
- Was keen to see maintenance of 11 Council clusters approach (and VTCs)
- But VTCs couldn't continue to be funded if have no role
- Governance proposals from Sector (26 Councils) – Minister asked for re-consideration of VTC role



Collaboration and Efficiency

- Expect plans and business case on costs and efficiencies by end of year
- Minister sees this as hugely important
- Benefits all accrue to Councils
- Commonsense approach can't continue 26 or 11 times replication of services



FUTURE

- Potentially 2014 shadow period
- Potentially 2015 elections to 11 Councils
- Dependent on Executive decisions after the election in 2011
- Collaboration and efficiency agenda agreed and well in progress
