

What is Zero Waste Scotland?

- Not-for-profit organisation
- Funded by the Scottish Government
- Delivery body for Scottish Government waste strategies
- Based in Stirling with links to all four nations through WRAP

Scotland's Zero Waste Plan

- Launched 9th June 2010 sets out vision
 - Focus on all waste types not just MSW
 - Appreciate value of resources
 - Emphasis on prevention activities
 - Reduce impact on environment
 - Deliver the 42% carbon reduction
 - Contribute to economic growth
 - Paving the way for landfill bans














Mandatory source segregation and separate collection

- Economic opportunity for the waste management sector
- Responsibility of producers to deal with their waste appropriately
- Does not apply to householders
- Keep source segregated materials:
 - free from contamination (mixing ban)
 - out of landfill (material based bans)
 - away from incineration (restrictions)
- Supports the economic case for recycling









Landfill Bans

- Material based bans do not mean that these materials won't end up in landfill Supports the source segregation measures and is not a pretreatment requirement.
- Property based ban is a pre-treatment requirement
 Mitigate climate change impacts of landfill
