# Recommendations



## Increased stock holding

Recommended level over medium term of 12 days / 48 runs

Most councils currently re-stocking at higher levels than last year

Wide variation in stocks – lowest in South East  
Collaboration promoted

Interim report - HA to buy 0.25m tonnes from abroad; premium cost to encourage planning by other users; final reserve stock in emergencies

## Regular monitoring

Stocks already monitored

Expected to establish a comprehensive monitoring system

Intention is to avoid activating the Salt Cell
