Recommendations



Greater efficiencies in salt utilisation

- Guidance available appropriate and effective levels
- No overspreading
- Conserving stocks
- Reducing costs
- Local decision

Recommendations



Increased stock holding

- Recommended level over medium term of 12 days / 48 runs
- Most councils currently re-stocking at higher levels than last year
- Wide variation in stocks lowest in South East
- Collaboration promoted

Interim report - HA to buy 0.25m tonnes from abroad; premium cost to encourage planning by other users; final reserve stock in emergencies

Regular monitoring

Stocks already monitored

- Expected to establish a comprehensive monitoring system
- Intention is to avoid activating the Salt Cell
