Halton Borough Council's Efficiency Review



In January 2009 external consultants brought in to look at the structure of the entire Council. Halton Borough Council had to save £5 Million from its Budgets just to stand still.

The following year Halton learned that it would have to take £20 Million out of its budgets in year 2011/12 and recently we have calculated that we need to take out £15 Million next year.

The greenspace functions were evaluated in 2009. The result was the creation of Open Space Services in February 2010. In total £531,000 was taken out of the budgets.

Since the review



- Continued to deliver a quality service.
- Retained 12 Green Flag Awards
- Balanced the budget
- Had a positive review report (APSE)

In December 2010 the service was Redesignated yet again. The functions of Bereavement Services and the events Service, including Rangers was merged With effect from 1st April 2011 saving £300,000.
