




CASE STUDY – 09-10 PROGRAMME

•12 companies from diverse sectors.

over 800MWh of energy savings identified

£250,000+ Identified Savings 35 tonnes

materials avoided.

183 tonnes

landfill reduced

148 tonnes of waste recycled.





CASE STUDY – ODYSSEY ARENA

- Identified energy savings of £38,000/year in electricity.
- 90% recycle rates achieved.
- 1,250 batteries a year plus
 £6,200/year estimated on purchasing batteries.
- Improved staff and contractor environmental awareness.
- Formal environmental management system in place which can be registered to BS 8555 level 3.
