





### Starting point - Must be in a sound condition

It is vital when working on a Smart Maintenance cyclical maintenance programme, that the substrate be brought back to a sound condition

Time spent on ensuring this will be repaid later with a lower maintenance requirement.











### Site Specific - Cost Control

#### **Exposure conditions**

Different exposure conditions suggest particular decorative regimes

A sound cyclical maintenance programme should take full account of differing redecoration requirements












# **Site Specific - Cost Control**

#### **Exposure conditions**

Sheltered elevations west to east via north minimum rain and sun require less protection



Exposed elevations west to east via south maximum rain and sun require more protection



### **Exposure conditions**

### **Indoors**

A room that is only used infrequently by a small number of people should require far less routine decoration than a high traffic area.

The use of highly durable finishes in high traffic, high wear areas can keep them looking good for longer and extend painting cycles

Zoning a building by wear and usage can keep it looking good while extending maintenance cycles to some areas and reducing costs.























#### **Red & Green; Colour opposites**


But a visually impaired person struggles to identify different colours and instead sees only light and dark...





